Notes for guidance

The Health Professions Council (Election Scheme) Rules 2004 provides that the expenditure incurred by or on behalf of a candidate in the conduct or management of any election must not exceed £500.

For the purpose of those Rules "relevant expenditure" is expenditure incurred in the conduct and management of the election between 5 February 2007 (the date on which the Returning Officer published the notice of the date of the nomination day) and 25 May 2007 (polling day) and includes, but is not limited to:

- the cost of preparing pamphlets or circulars;
- the cost of advertisements in newspapers or elsewhere;
- the cost of meetings convened for the purpose of the election (including a share in the costs of such meetings arranged by or for candidates jointly); and
- postal and telephone charges incurred in connection with the election.

Relevant expenditure does not include:

- the reasonable travelling and subsistence expenses of the candidate and the candidate's family
- the reasonable travelling and subsistence expenses of other persons which are not defrayed by or on behalf of the candidate; or
- any costs incurred by the Council, the Returning Officer of the Independent Scrutineer in relation to the election.

The Rules require election expenditure returns to be received by the Returning Officer not later than fourteen days after the appointment of members in accordance with those Rules and, for this election, the deadline for receipt of returns is 13th June 2007.

The Rules also require the Returning Officer to publish all election expenditure returns in such manner as the Council may determine and, for this purpose, the Council has determined that the returns will be published on the HPC website.
